Yes Deer can play on backline in smaller rooms, but generally prefer playing on a PA system if it's available.

Backline:

Guitar:

1 Vox AC30 or 1 Fender Twin Reverb or any similar loud tube amplifier for guitar
1 Ampeg SVT with cabinet or similar loud bass amplifier for synth
1 stand for synthesizer

Saxophone:

1 Fender(**guitar**) tube amplifier or similar loud tube amplifier

Drums:

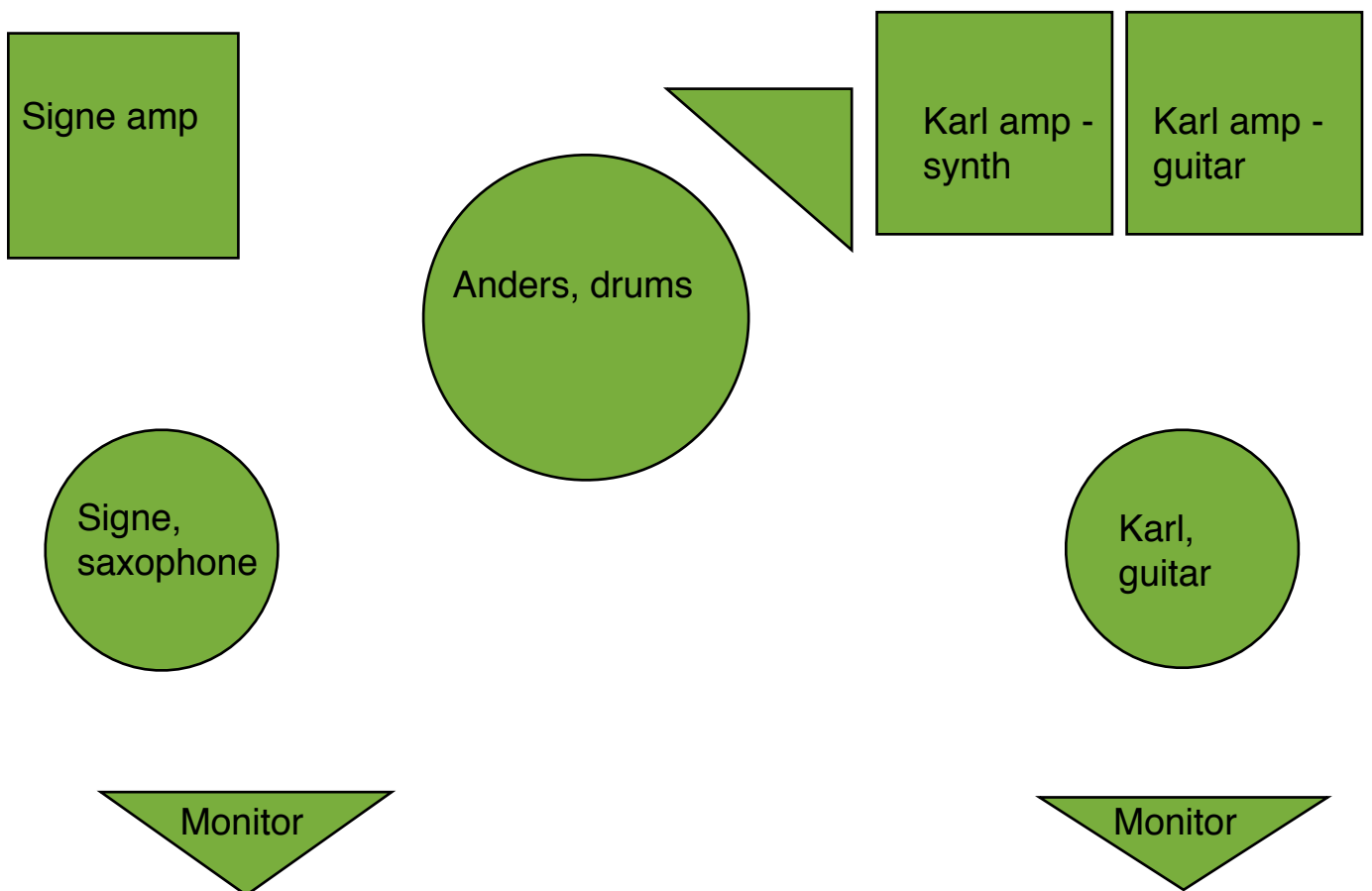
Bass drum 20"
Snare drum 14"
Tom tom 12" or 13"
Floor tom 14" or 16"
2 snare drum stands
2 cymbal stands
1 hi-hat stand
1 bass drum pedal
1 height adjustable drum chair
1 drum carpet
Something heavy to put in front of the bass drum so it doesn't move

All drums should have coated heads (preferably Remo Ambassador).
Preferred brands are pre 70's Gretsch or Slingerland or similar.

On Stage:

Simple micing for drum kit. Close micing on kick drum, toms and snare
SM57 or e906 for the guitar amplifiers, or any mic you find sufficient
3 monitors (**only needed on big stages**)
3 bottles of water
